NOTE: You must possess both the **Minimum *and* Selective Qualifications** to be considered for this position.

POSITION DUTIES: This is the advanced level of technical electronic work in the repair, maintenance and installation of standard and special purpose electronic equipment. This position installs, repairs and assembles Electronic Security Systems and surveillance systems in all required Arms, Ammunition & Explosives (AA&E) assets in the State. Assists the ESS Supervisor in all aspects of ESS in regards to MILCON, Sustainment, Renovation and Modernization (SRM) projects and conducts quarterly/annual inspections of all Electronic Security Systems within the State.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from a standard high school or possession of a State high school equivalency certificate, *and*

Successful completion of a formal course in electronics theory, practice and equipment at a recognized school in electronics, radio, or television repair.

EXPERIENCE: Three years of full-time employment or its equivalent in electronics equipment, radio, or television repair.

NOTE: Applicants may substitute additional experience in electronic repair work or formal schooling in electronics, on a year for year basis, for up to two years of required high school education.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE CLASSIFICATION:

1. Some positions in this classification are assigned duties which will require the individual to be examined by a physician. After an offer of employment, applicants for such positions will be given a medical examination to certify the ability to perform the essential job functions.
2. Persons appointed to this position may, in some departments, be subject to call twenty-four hours a day in emergencies.

SELECTIVE QUALIFICATIONS:

1. **Two years** of experience installing, operating and maintaining Alarm and Electronic Security Systems for buildings and facilities, *or*
2. **One year** of experience installing, operating and maintaining Electronic Security and Intrusion Detection Systems for a military organization such as the National Guard.

QUALIFICATIONS: You must possess the minimum and selective qualifications to be considered for this position. **For education obtained outside the U.S., you will be required to provide proof of the equivalent American education as determined by a foreign credential evaluation service. This evaluation must be submitted with your application.** All information used to determine your qualifications must be submitted by the closing date. Therefore, be sure that you accurately and thoroughly complete the application.

EXAMINATION: The examination will consist of a rating of your education, training, and experience related to the requirements of the position. Therefore, it is important that you provide complete and accurate information on your application. Report all experience and education that is related to this position. For each position held, applicants should list the different types of appeals they handled and specify their responsibility for each type. **All information concerning your qualifications must be submitted by the closing date. We will not consider information submitted after this date.** Successful candidates will be ranked as Best Qualified, Better Qualified, or Qualified and placed on the employment (eligible) list for at least one year.
